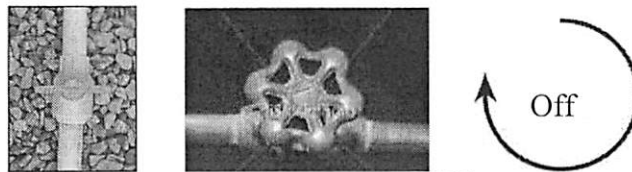


NOTICE

The Queens Subdivision Irrigation Water System is scheduled to be turned ON Monday, April 9th.

Please turn off your valve located on the irrigation water system riser located in the rear of your yard. This is important to prevent flooding of your and your neighbor's property in the event of a leak in your system!



Valve shown in the "Off" position. Note: all valves turn clockwise to turn off.

The pumps are scheduled to run 7 days a week at 4:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and again in the evening from 4:00 p.m. 11:00 p.m. throughout the season. The pressure in the system will be between about 50 to 65 p.s.i., depending on the amount of demand on the lines.

You should plan to be home on the day that you turn on your yard system, and to turn on your supply valve to test for leaks in your yard system. If you see any signs of escaping water from anywhere in the system, or from anyone's yard, please immediately notify Ron Davis of RD Sprinklers who installed and helps maintain our irrigation water system at 234-4951 or Don Warner at 639-0693 or Heritage Property Management at 243-3186.

There is an emergency shut-off switch on the pump house building located at the park at the corner of Heath and Cliffrose. The switch is located high on the west side of the building.
