### Safety Issues

- Street Lighting
  - o Lights that were out or dim have been fixed by Grand Valley Power
- Cracks in Street on East end of Royal Ct
  - City has been out to inspect and has deemed the cracks "not unsafe"
  - Our neighborhood is not scheduled for chip seal until 2016

# 629 Monarch Glen Loop

- Board and Heritage have received complaints from a neighbor about continuous dog barking
- Complainant was advised in April to contact animal control
  - O Complainant says animal control advised other neighbors and the HOA also need to make a complaint.
  - Don also called animal control and received a written response stating:
    - They issued a formal or official bark warning at this address;
    - We must allow seven days for owner to rectify the situation.
    - Response also provided recommendations for documentation of barking for further action to be taken.
      - Anissa will take this letter to Heritage and have them send a response to complainant with a copy of the letter from animal control.
  - o Linda at Heritage has sent a letter to the renter at this property requesting they control the barking issue or fines will be imposed.
